## GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION

### Arrival

- Absolutely no arrivals before 12:00 pm EST on Wednesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. Horses or equipment on the grounds before 12:00 pm will be charged \$100 per stall. NO EXCEPTIONS!

### Barn Calls

- Barn calls and announcements are a courtesy. While they will be made for each class, regardless of circumstances it is ultimately the exhibitor's responsibility to report to their class on time.

### Coggins & Health Papers

- All horses are required to have a current Coggins and 30-day health certificate to enter the show grounds. These may be inspected by the facility upon arrival.

### Departure

- All horses must be departed from the show grounds no later than 8:00 am EST on Sunday, June 1<sup>st</sup>. Any tack or horses still in stalls after 8:00 am SHARP will be charged \$100 per stall. NO EXCEPTIONS!

### Disputes

- Any dispute as to the operation of classes, matters of protocol, procedures in drug testing, show management issues and all other issues shall be decided by the show manager in consultation with Premier Sires. The show manager's decision shall be final and considered acceptable to all exhibitors.

### Dogs

- The Kentucky Horse Park requires all dogs to be on a leash at all times.

- Pre-entry deadline for AQHA and APHA classes is May 16<sup>th</sup>. Pre-entries can only be made through Horse Show Tracker. If you don't pre enter through Horse Show Tracker by May 16<sup>th</sup> there is a \$50 late entry fee. Horse Show Tracker requires a credit card to submit entries however cards are NOT charged, and classes can be scratched at the show with no penalty.
- If you don't close out your tab, there will be an additional \$45 charge applied.
- If you are entering at the gate, you may not enter Level 2, NSBA or futurity classes.

#### **High Point Awards**

- AQHA High Point and Reserve High Points will be awarded in the following divisions: Level 1 Youth, Level 1 Amateur, 13 & Under Youth, 14-18 Youth, Amateur, Select Amateur, Junior, Senior and Small-Fry.
- All levels count within each division. For example, Level 2 Junior counts towards the Junior High Point.
- Exhibitors must show in their respective Halter class to qualify. Halter is not required for the Level 1 and Small-Fry but will count.
- All awards must be picked up at the show. Awards will not be shipped after the show.

#### **Hotel**

#### **Kentucky Horse Park Parking**

- Parking around the barns is not permitted. Please pay attention to posted parking signs. Parking in a no parking zone may result in a ticket or fine.

#### **Longing**

- Except for yearlings competing in Longe Line classes, there is absolutely NO LONGING anywhere but the designated longing arenas. After the first warning, exhibitors are subject to a fine of up to \$100 per violation.

#### **Non-Pro Green Classes**

- AQHA rules and eligibility apply. Verification of eligibility is the responsibility of the exhibitor prior to making an entry.

#### **Photography & Videography**

- The official show photographer is Shane Rux Photography.
- Media outlets wishing to cover the event are welcome but must request and be granted a media pass and abide by all media requirements which can be found on our website. Failure to do so will result in immediate removal from the show grounds.
- By way of attendance at or entry into the event, competitors, and their respective employees, agents and family members grant the permission without remuneration for the use and public distribution of their image, likeness, voice, and video for the possible promotion of the event. All exhibitors will be subject to the use of photographers and cinematographers under the direction of show management for the benefit of show promotion.

#### **Premier Magazine Classes**

- Premier Magazine classes are open to everyone. Horses do not have to be sired by a Premier Sires stallion to show in these classes.
- All futurity winnings will be mailed 45 days after the completion of the show. If the entry does not have a social security or tax ID number or invalid social security or Tax ID number is provided, winnings will not be mailed, and we will not reach out to track down this information. Premier Sires is not responsible for incorrect addresses. Exhibitors have until September 15, 2025 to notify Premier Sires of any missing payments otherwise winnings will be forfeited.
- Pre-Entry Deadline: April 18, 2025.
- Late entries will be accepted up until 12:00 pm the day before the class shows, however a late fee of 50% of the original entry fee will apply per class entered. Entries made after 12:00 pm the day before the class shows will be accepted however an additional late fee of \$500 will apply per class entered (this is in addition to the initial late fee).
- Exhibitors will show to three judges. No scores will be dropped.

#### **Premier Sires Classes**

- All futurity classes which are not otherwise designated as Premier Magazine or Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation Challenge, are Premier Sires classes (also designated by **blue, bold font**). Horses born in or after 2018 must be nominated to Premier Sires and have a certificate of eligibility in the name of the current owner to show in any Premier Sires class. Horses born in or before 2017 must either have been nominated to Premier Sires or be sired by a currently enrolled stallion.



- All Premier Sires classes will follow Premier Sires riders lists. Unless it specifies horse, any reference to "Level" or "Lvl" for a Premier Sires class indicates rider level.
- All futurity winnings will be mailed 45 days after the completion of the show. If the entry does not have a social security or tax ID number or invalid social security or Tax ID number is provided, winnings will not be mailed, and we will not reach out to track down this information. Premier Sires is not responsible for incorrect addresses. Exhibitors have until September 15, 2025 to notify Premier Sires of any missing payments otherwise winnings will be forfeited.
- Pre-Entry Deadline: April 18, 2025.
- Late entries will be accepted up until 12:00 pm the day before the class shows, however a late fee of 50% of the original entry fee will apply per class entered. Entries made after 12:00 pm the day before the class shows will be accepted however an additional late fee of \$1,000 will apply per class entered (this is in addition to the initial late fee).
- Breeders Futurity Classes: All Level 1 Riders must show in the Level 1 Prelims to show in the Level 1 Finals. All Level 1 riders who show in the Level 1 Prelims are eligible to show in the Level 1 Finals regardless of placing.
- Breeders Futurity Longe Line: An exhibitor may only show two horses per class. If classes run concurrently an exhibitor may still only show a total of 2 horses per class block.
- 3-Year-Old Limited Horse Limited Rider WP/HUS: All horses will show both the 1<sup>st</sup> go and finals. Placings will be withheld from the first go and horses will be placed under all eight cards following the finals. The overall placings will be based on the composite score under all eight judges with both the high and low score dropped. Guest judges may be used at Premier Sires discretion.
- 3-Year-Old Maiden Western Pleasure & Hunter Under Saddle: Exhibitors will show to five judges. The high and low score for each exhibitor will be dropped to determine final placings.
- Breeders Futurity and Stakes classes: Exhibitors will show to three judges. No scores will be dropped.

This includes duplicate entries, ineligible entries, or entries into the wrong class. It is your responsibility to ensure that you or your agent are entering the correct classes.

#### Ranch Trail Futurity

- The Open and Non-Pro divisions will run concurrently. A horse may only show in one division.
- All futurity winnings will be mailed 45 days after the completion of the show. If the entry does not have a social security or tax ID number or invalid social security or Tax ID number is provided, winnings will not be mailed, and we will not reach out to track down this information. Premier Sires is not responsible for incorrect addresses. Exhibitors have until September 15, 2025 to notify Premier Sires of any missing payments otherwise winnings will be forfeited.
- Entry Fee: \$250. Must enter by 12:00 pm the day before or a late fee will apply. An obstacle fee of \$25 will also apply.

#### Rules and Regulations

- AQHA and NSBA rules take precedence for all class and equipment rules, except when superseded by Premier Sires rules.
- APHA rules will apply for all APHA classes.
- All horses are subject to drug testing by blood and/or urine. NSBA rules regarding illegal substances will govern all futurity classes.
- No person shall treat any horse in a cruel or inhumane manner, including, but not limited to, the prohibited conduct specified in the AQHA, APHA and NSBA handbooks.
- Premier Sires will honor all AQHA, APHA and NSBA suspensions. Individuals or entities suspended by one or more of these organizations will be prohibited from competing in any Premier Sires or Premier Magazine class.

#### RVs

- VIP RV Reservations: VIP camping spots (otherwise referred to by KHP as "Tent City") are inside the Kentucky Horse Park grounds, closer to the barns and show arenas. The VIP spots have been reserved for show sponsors (select sponsor levels only) and must be booked through Premier Sires.
- All other RV spots can be reserved by contacting the KHP Campground at 859-259-4257 and when prompted dial "2" to be directed to the campground store to make your reservation for "The Premier AQHA Show."
- All RV spots all have 30- & 50amp power and water. There is a dump station on the grounds.

#### Schedule

- Classes shown **BOXED** are run concurrently. Some futurity classes may be run concurrently or separated to run individually if entries warrant.
- Show management reserves the right to make changes as necessary at any time, including but not limited to schedule, arena or fee changes.
- Arena announcements are a courtesy it is the exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of the arena timing.

#### Stalls

- Any other veterinarian wishing to work on the grounds at The Premier must complete the vendor form, submit the veterinarian vendor fee and be approved by the show prior to arrival. Show staff reserves the right to limit the number of veterinarians practicing on the show grounds. Any veterinarian who fails to complete the vendor fee, pay the vendor fee and obtain prior approval from show management will be removed from the show grounds and not permitted to return. Any veterinarian found to be performing procedures not-sanctioned by AQHA, APHA or NSBA or in violation of animal welfare rules and regulations will be excused from the grounds and not permitted to return.
